DÉCISION

On September 11, 2001, the applicant was ordered :

- to state, in writing and before November 2001, the reasons for which a specific decision, made by the person in charge of access to documents for the Public Protector, should be reviewed by the Commission;
- to send his statement to the Commission and to the Public Protector.

The applicant failed to comply with this order.

The Commission therefore believes that its intervention for a review would clearly serve no purpose.

Pursuant to section 130.1 of the *Act respecting Access to documents held by public bodies and the Protection of personal information*, the Commission refuses to examine the application for review made by the applicant :

130.1 The Commission may refuse or cease to examine a matter if it has reasonable cause to believe that the request is frivolous or made in bad faith or that its intervention would clearly serve no purpose.
